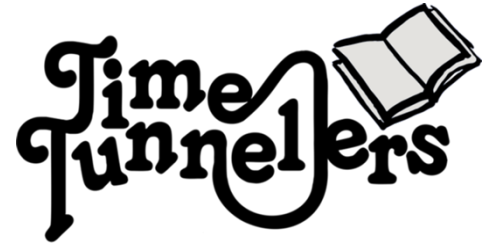


Get your groove on!
