



Andrew who? Write a persuasive letter or speech to demand a National Monument for Andrew de Moray!

Background: In 1297, William Wallace and Andrew de Moray combined forces to confront the English army at the Battle of Stirling Bridge. Both men wanted the exiled John Balliol back on the Scottish throne. But the English King, Edward I, was determined to control Scotland and had invaded. The countries had always been separate up to this point.

Writing task: Write a letter or a speech arguing that Andrew de Moray should be given a national monument and be celebrated just as William Wallace is.
